

Tuition & Fees Overview Academic Year 2025 – 2026

Undergraduate programs

Annual Tuition & Fees – American Bachelor’s programs

- EU/EFTA Nationals & Czech Permanent Residents: 252,300 CZK (≈ 10,040 EUR / 10,460 USD)
- International Students: 304,800 CZK (≈ 12,130 EUR / 12,630 USD)

Tuition Breakdown:

Tuition is calculated based on the number of courses/credits that students are taking per semester. The duration of the American Bachelor’s programs is 4 years (2 semesters per year). Students must complete 92 UNYP credits and 32 SUNY - Empire State University credits to graduate. Typically, each course is worth 3 credits.

Tuition per UNYP credit

- EU/EFTA Nationals & Czech Permanent Residents: 7,950 CZK
- International Students: 9,700 CZK

Tuition per SUNY-Empire State University credit

- 355 USD

Fees Breakdown:

- Application Fee (non-refundable): 2,000 CZK (one time only)
- Student Body Fee: 6900 CZK per semester
- Reduced Student Body Fee: 3,300 CZK per semester
- Empire State University Admissions Fee: 365 USD (one time only)
- Empire State University Technology Fee: 194 USD per semester
- Transfer Credit Fee: 500 CZK per US credit
- Graduation Fee: 3,500 CZK (one time only)

Notes:

- Students pursuing the dual degree option must complete an additional 4 UNYP credits.

- For the American Bachelor program, the academic year is divided into two semesters, with each standard semester consisting of 5 courses.
- The reduced student body fee applies to students enrolled in fewer credits per semester and replaces the full student body fee.
- The Empire State University Admissions Fee is charged after the second year of study.
- The Empire State University Technology Fee is charged per semester beginning in the third year of study.
- The transfer credit fee applies only to students transferring courses from previous studies.
- These prices are valid starting from Fall 2025.
- Tuition rates are subject to change during the next academic year.

Example of Tuitions and Fees, Semester

- EU/EFTA Nationals & Czech Permanent Residents

Standard of 5 courses semester x 3 credits per course = 15 credits

15 credits x 7,950 CZK Tuition per credit = 119,250 CZK + 6,900 Student Body Fee = 126,150 CZK (≈ 5,020 EUR / 5,230 USD)

- International Students

Standard of 5 courses semester x 3 credits per course = 15 credits

15 credits x 9,700 CZK Tuition per credit = 145,500 CZK + 6,900 Student Body Fee = 152,400 CZK (≈ 6,070 EUR / 6,315 USD)

Tuition fees are determined in CZK, with the EUR and USD amounts provided as estimates based on the December 2024 exchange rate.

Freshman students may be required to take one additional credit (Introduction to University Studies) during their first semester.

Example of Tuitions and Fees, Annual

- EU/EFTA Nationals & Czech Permanent Residents

Standard of 5 courses semester x 2 semesters = 10 courses x 3 credits per course = 30 credits

30 credits x 7,950 CZK Tuition per credit = 238,500 CZK + 13,800 CZK Student Body Fee (2 x 6900 CZK) = 252,300 CZK (≈ 10,040 EUR / 10,460 USD)

- International Students

Standard of 5 courses semester x 2 semesters = 10 courses x 3 credits per course = 30 credits

30 credits x 9,700 CZK Tuition per credit = 291,100 CZK + 13,800 CZK Student Body Fee (2 x 6900 CZK) = 304,800 CZK (≈ 12,140 EUR / 12,630 USD)

Tuition fees are determined in CZK, with the EUR and USD amounts provided as estimates based on the December 2024 exchange rate.

Freshman students may be required to take one additional credit (Introduction to University Studies) during their first semester.

Annual Tuition & Fees – European Bachelor’s programs

- EU/EFTA Nationals & Czech Permanent Residents: 252,300 CZK (≈ 10,040 EUR / 10,460 USD)
- International Students: 283,800 CZK (≈ 11,290 EUR / 11,740 USD)

Tuition Breakdown:

Tuition is calculated based on the number of courses/credits that students are taking per semester. The duration of the European Bachelor’s programs is 3 years (2 semesters per year). Students must complete 180 ECTS credits to graduate. Typically, each course is worth 6 ECTS credits.

Tuition per UNYP credit

- EU/EFTA Nationals & Czech Permanent Residents: 3,975 CZK
- International Students: 4,500 CZK

Fees Breakdown:

- Application Fee (non-refundable): 2,000 CZK (one time only)
- Student Body Fee: 6900 CZK per semester
- Reduced Student Body Fee: 3,300 CZK per semester
- Transfer Credit Fee: 250 CZK per ECTS credit
- Graduation Fee: 3,500 CZK (one time only)

30 credits x 3,975 CZK Tuition per credit = 119,250 CZK + 6,900 Student Body Fee = 126,150 CZK (≈ 5,020 EUR / 5,230 USD)

- International Students

Standard of 5 courses semester x 6 credits per course = 30 credits

30 credits x 4,500 CZK Tuition per credit = 135,000 CZK + 6,900 Student Body Fee = 141,900 CZK (≈ 5,645 EUR / 5,870 USD)

Tuition fees are determined in CZK, with the EUR and USD amounts provided as estimates based on the December 2024 exchange rate.

Freshman students may be required to take two additional credits (Introduction to University Studies) during their first semester.

Example of Tuitions and Fees, Annual

- EU/EFTA Nationals & Czech Permanent Residents

Standard of 5 courses semester x 2 semesters = 10 courses x 6 credits per course = 60 credits

60 credits x 3,975 CZK Tuition per credit = 238,500 CZK + 13,800 CZK Student Body Fee (2 x 6900 CZK) = 252,300 CZK (≈ 10,040 EUR / 10,460 USD)

- International Students

Standard of 5 courses semester x 2 semesters = 10 courses x 6 credits per course = 60 credits

60 credits x 4,500 CZK Tuition per credit = 270,000 CZK + 13,800 CZK Student Body Fee (2 x 6900 CZK) = 283,800 CZK (≈ 11,290 EUR / 11,740 USD)

Tuition fees are determined in CZK, with the EUR and USD amounts provided as estimates based on the December 2024 exchange rate.

Freshman students may be required to take two additional credits (Introduction to University Studies) during their first semester.

Graduate programs

Tuition for the entire duration of the programs

- Master's in Psychology: 410,000 CZK (≈ 16,300 EUR / 16,950 USD)
- Master's in Business Administration (MBA): 410,000 CZK (≈ 16,300 EUR / 16,950 USD)
- Master's in Digital Marketing and Analytics: 350,000 CZK (≈ 13,920 EUR / 14,480 USD)

Fees Breakdown:

- Application Fee (non-refundable): 2,000 CZK (one time only)
- Graduation Fee: 3,500 CZK (one time only)

- Graduate program tuition covers the entire duration of the program.
